**Freestanding emergency room (FSER):** FSERs, sometimes referred to as urgency centers, typically bill at ER rates (or higher) and can cost \$1,500 more than an urgent care center. Neither located in nor attached to a hospital, FSERs are able to treat similar conditions as an ER, but cannot admit patients.

**Important note:** If you experience a true emergency, dial 911 or go to the nearest emergency room.
